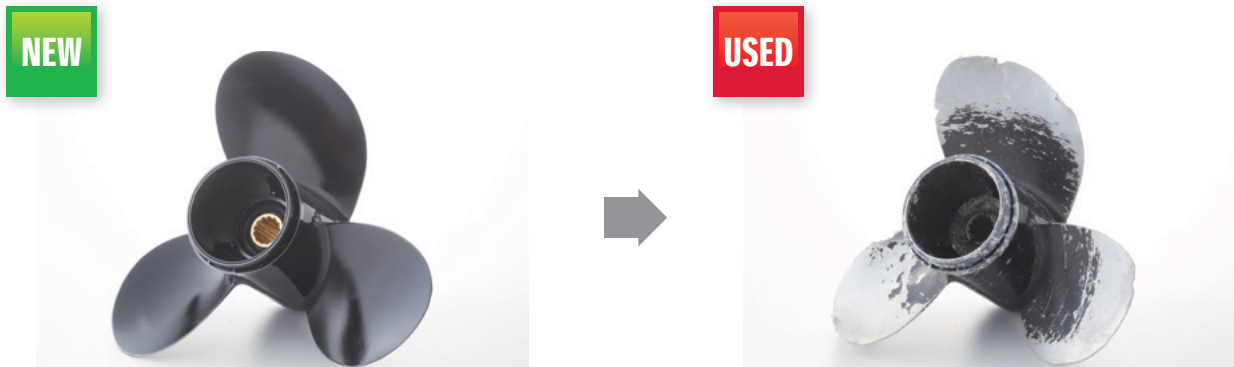

Purpose and Function

The propeller is the piece of equipment to transfer the engine power into usable thrust. Propeller selection is the key to optimum performance and economy. It is essential to use a propeller on your outboard motor that is properly matched to your boat. Lighter-load boats generally require larger-pitch propellers while heavier-load boats generally require smaller-pitch ones.



If overused without replacement ...

- **When keep using the propeller which has been worn small and thin, it makes excessive engine speed and causes a serious damage to the motor. When keep using the propeller which has been damaged and unbalanced, it causes a serious vibration to the motor and boat.**

You can get optimum acceleration, improved middle and top speed, smooth and economy cruising by replacing the worn or damaged propellers with new ones.
